<b>Qualification Title</b>	L3 First Aid At Work
<b>Course Duration</b>	3 Days
	A minimum of 18 hours ideally over three consecutive days. However, the sessions can be spread over a number of weeks should this better suit the needs of your business. The course must be completed within 10 weeks of the start date and each session must be at least two hours long.
<b>Certificate Validity</b>	3 years

<b>Description</b>	<p>It is a requirement of the Health &amp; Safety law that employers provide a safe and healthy environment to work in. If your assessment of first aid needs highlights the need for qualified first aiders, then this level 3 qualification will provide you with suitable, highly trained personnel.</p> <p>This comprehensive three day Ofqual approved course covers a wide range of first aid emergencies, enabling all participants to deal with emergency situations with confidence in a prompt, safe and effective way. In addition, this course will include any protocol changes that may have arisen since any previous training.</p> <p>This course will give participants a qualification to the highest level of First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.</p> <p>All successful students will be issued a FAAW certificate lasting 3 years. The course covers all aspects of basic life support including CPR, bleeding, unconsciousness, choking, head injuries, sprains and strains and a vast range of First Aid conditions that you may experience in the workplace, refer to syllabus below for further details.</p>
<b>Who should attend?</b>	Students must be a minimum of 14 years of age. A student cannot assume a responsibility in the workplace until they reach the age of 16, and then it is the employer's responsibility to ensure that the student is suitable for that role.
<b>Syllabus</b>	A range of subjects are covered including legalities, responsibilities & reporting, dealing with an unresponsive casualty, fractures & spinal injuries, control of bleeding, poisoning, burns, epilepsy, resuscitation & AED awareness, bandaging, heart attacks, head injuries, chest injuries, asthma, stroke, assessment of the situation, shock (including anaphylaxis), choking, eye injuries, sprains & strains, diabetes.
<b>Assessment &amp; Certification</b>	Practical assessment is ongoing by the instructor throughout the course, along with a written assessment each day. Subject to successful assessment a three year L3 FAAW certificate will be issued.
