<b>Qualification Title</b>	L3 First Aid At Work (Re-Qualification)
<b>Course Duration</b>	2 Days
	A minimum of 12 hours spread over at least two days. Ideally the course should be run over two consecutive days. However, the sessions can be spread over a period of up to 6 weeks should this better suit the needs of your business. Each session must be at least two hours long.
<b>Certificate Validity</b>	3 years
<b>Max No of delegates</b>	12
<b>Description</b>	<p>This two day Ofqual approved FFAAW refresher course is for those who are currently qualified as a First Aider (FAAW) and wish to continue as an approved First Aider for another three years. The course covers all aspects of basic life support along with a vast range of First Aid conditions.</p> <p><b>The important thing to remember is that as soon as the FFAAW certificate expires, the First Aider is no longer considered competent to act as a First Aider in the workplace which may well leave the employer with a shortfall of First Aiders. Therefore, it would be prudent to arrange requalification before expiry.</b></p>
<b>Who should attend?</b>	<p>This two day requalification course is designed for those who currently hold a First Aid at Work qualification which is due to expire.</p> <p>A First Aider can renew their FFAAW by attending this course if it's within one month of the expiry date of their FFAAW certificate. If the First Aider has lapsed by more than one month but less than 3, then the First Aider can requalify by attending a 2-day course providing special considerations have been applied, please check with us for details. If three months or longer has elapsed then the student must attend a full 3-day FFAAW course.</p> <p>Students must be a minimum of 14 years of age. A student cannot assume a responsibility in the workplace until they reach the age of 16, and then it is the employer's responsibility to ensure that the student is suitable for that role.</p>
<b>Syllabus</b>	A range of subjects are covered including legalities, responsibilities & reporting, dealing with an unresponsive casualty, fractures & spinal injuries, control of bleeding, poisoning, burns, epilepsy, resuscitation & AED awareness, bandaging, heart attacks, head injuries, chest injuries, asthma, stroke, assessment of the situation, shock (including anaphylaxis), choking, eye injuries, sprains & strains, diabetes.
<b>Assessment &amp; Certification</b>	Practical assessment is ongoing by the instructor throughout the course, along with a written assessment each day. Subject to successful assessment a three year L3 FFAAW certificate will be issued.
<b>Refresher Training Recommended</b>	Annually
