<b>Qualification Title</b>	L3 Emergency First Aid At Work
<b>Course Duration</b>	1 Day
	A minimum of 6 hours in the classroom, consisting of practical and theoretical activities. The sessions can be spread over a maximum of 3 weeks should this better suit the needs of your business. Each session must be at least two hours long.
<b>Certificate Validity</b>	3 years

<b>Description</b>	<p>Compliant with HSE code of practice. Where an organisation's risk assessment of First Aid needs identifies that there is a requirement for Emergency First Aid practitioners, then this national Award in Emergency First Aid at Work satisfies the requirements of the regulatory body for First Aid – the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).</p> <p>All learners will finish the course with the skills and knowledge required to provide the organisation with Emergency First Aiders able to provide treatment to their casualties in a prompt, safe and effective manner.</p> <p>This one day Ofqual approved course comprises of practical and theoretical training covering responsibilities, assessment of the situation, first aid hygiene, resuscitation, anatomy, choking, bleeding, shock, epilepsy, minor injuries and dealing with an unresponsive casualty, see syllabus below for further details.</p>
<b>Who should attend?</b>	Students must be a minimum of 14 years of age. A student cannot assume a responsibility in the workplace until they reach the age of 16, and then it is the employer's responsibility to ensure that the student is suitable for that role.
<b>Syllabus</b>	A range of subjects are covered including responsibilities & reporting, assessment of the situation, dealing with an unresponsive casualty, basic first aid hygiene, resuscitation & AED awareness, anatomy, minor injuries, bleeding control, burns, choking, epilepsy and shock.
<b>Assessment &amp; Certification</b>	Assessment is ongoing by the instructor, along with a multiple-choice question paper. Subject to successful assessment a three year L2 EFAW certificate will be issued.
<b>Refresher Training Recommended</b>	HSE strongly recommend annual refreshers (a 3-hour session).
